"Weeping Willows for Wichelt - Part II" By Karen E. Dudzinski Of Textured Treasures

Complete Design Size: 3 3/16" square (92 x 92 count) Fabric: Wichelt 28 count Brandywine Linen [76170]

Fibres:

DMC Floss: white, 3346, 4060 DMC #8 Perle: white DMC Satin: S5200 Valdani12: 0543


Beads (All from Mill Hill):

Petite: 40479, 42031 Glass & Frosted: 2058, 60479


Small Bugle: 70479

Other Supplies:


beading needle, tapestry needle for perle cotton




Bound Cross



Half-Drop



Eyelet - Square (over 8; even #'s in centre)



Read Attachment



Beaded Cross stitch Thread bead on after coming up at 1; and then run needle through bead again after coming up at 3 and before going to the back of fabric at 4.

Instructions:


- 1. This is the second part of the design. The first was released earlier in the year. Refer to part one for the major motif in the upper left corner, the lower left corner and the beaded flower in the lower right corner.
- 2. Above the beaded flower complete 10 Bound Cross stitch blocks: 3 base stitches with #8 white Perle, top central stitch [9-10 on stitch diagram above] with Valdani O543, bordered by two stitches [7-8, 11-12] using a single strand of S5200.
- 3. For the staircase pattern in the upper right corner, use 2 strands of DMC 3346 for the darker stitches and Valdani O543 for the lighter stitches. The bugle beads are then attached with a single strand of 3346; and the 42031 beads are Cross stitched on, also using a single strand of DMC 3346.
- 4. For the outer border, use DMC #8 white for the Cross stitches, 1 strand DMC 3346 for the Eyelets in the corners, 2 strands of DMC 4060 for the Bound Rhodes Half Drops, and 42031 beads are attached vertically with a single strand of white floss.
- 5. Congratulations, you have completed "Weeping Willows for Wichelt". We hope you enjoyed your experience.
