

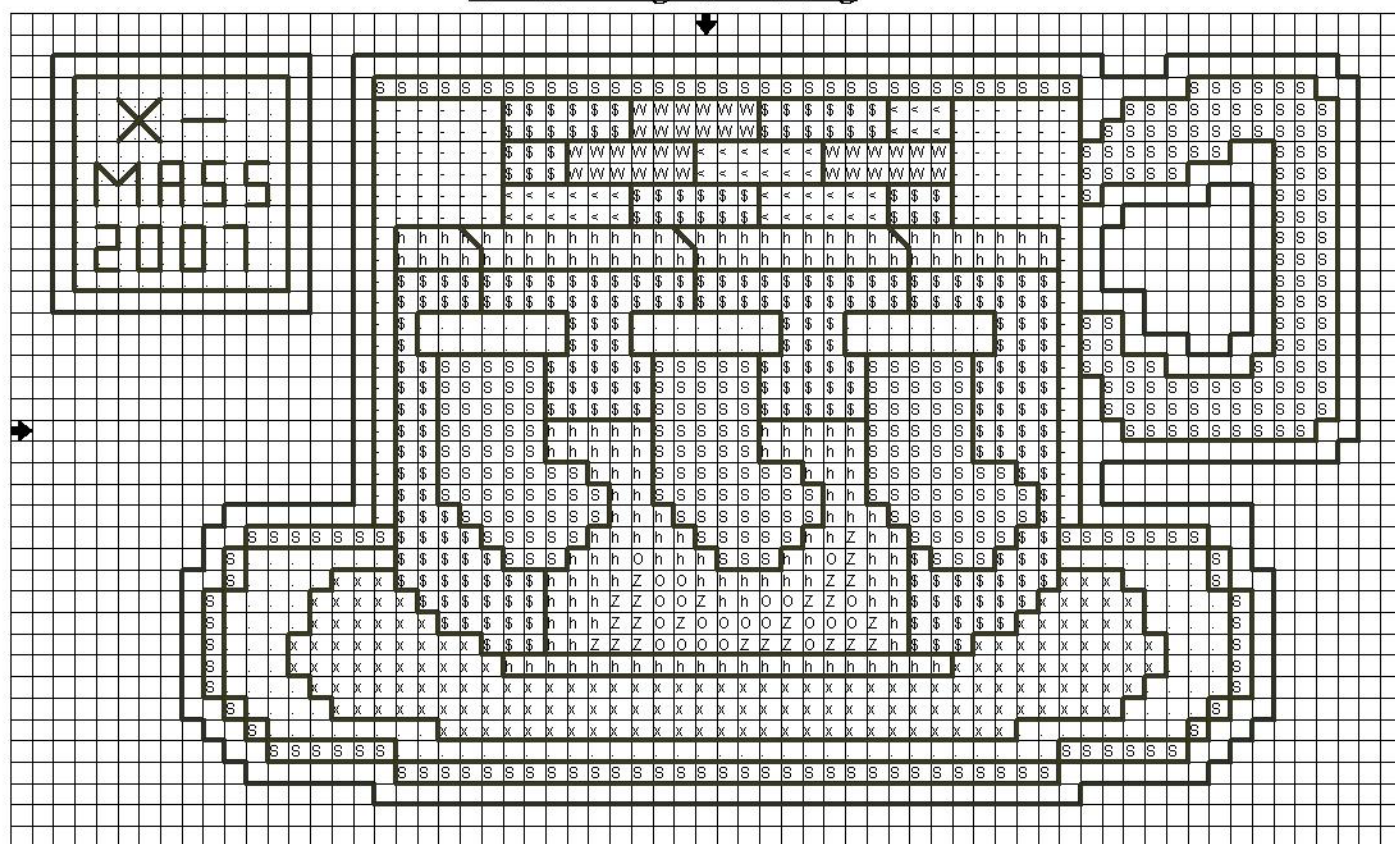


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The Stockings Were Hung



- White
- S #321 Christmas Red
- \$ #356 Terra Cotta~ Md
- Z #740 Tangerine
- < #758 Terra Cotta~ Vy Lt
- Backstitches: #3371 Black Brown
- W #920 Copper~ Md
- O #972 Canary~ Dk
- X #988 Forest Green~ Md
- h #3023 Brown Gray~ Lt
- #3770 Tawny~ Vy Lt
- Source Suggestion: PP1 White or PP2 Ecru
- Perforated Paper by Wichelt Imports.
- Fibers: DMC
- Stitch count: 61 w x 35 h, as shown on chart
- I would cut a piece of paper at least 4 3/4" w x 3".

Cross Stitches use 2 strands of floss. Backstitches are done with 1 strand of #3371, except where indicated below.

Backstitch specific instructions: The words: "x-mass" are done with 2 strands of #321. The year "2007" is done with 2 strands of #988. Not doing this in the year 2007?....change the year to fit. The stockings hooks are done with 2 strands of #3371.

Other instructions: when finished stitching, CAREFULLY using a small pair of sharp embroidery scissors cut around the tea cup and tea bag using the outer dark black lines as a guide. Once cut attach tea bag to upper edge of cup using 2 to 4 strands of #3770, by tying a knot to one end and leaving a tail to the other end so the bag dangles. Then attach another piece of floss around the tea cup handle. This will allow you to place ornament directly onto a tree or to attach a hook.

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
