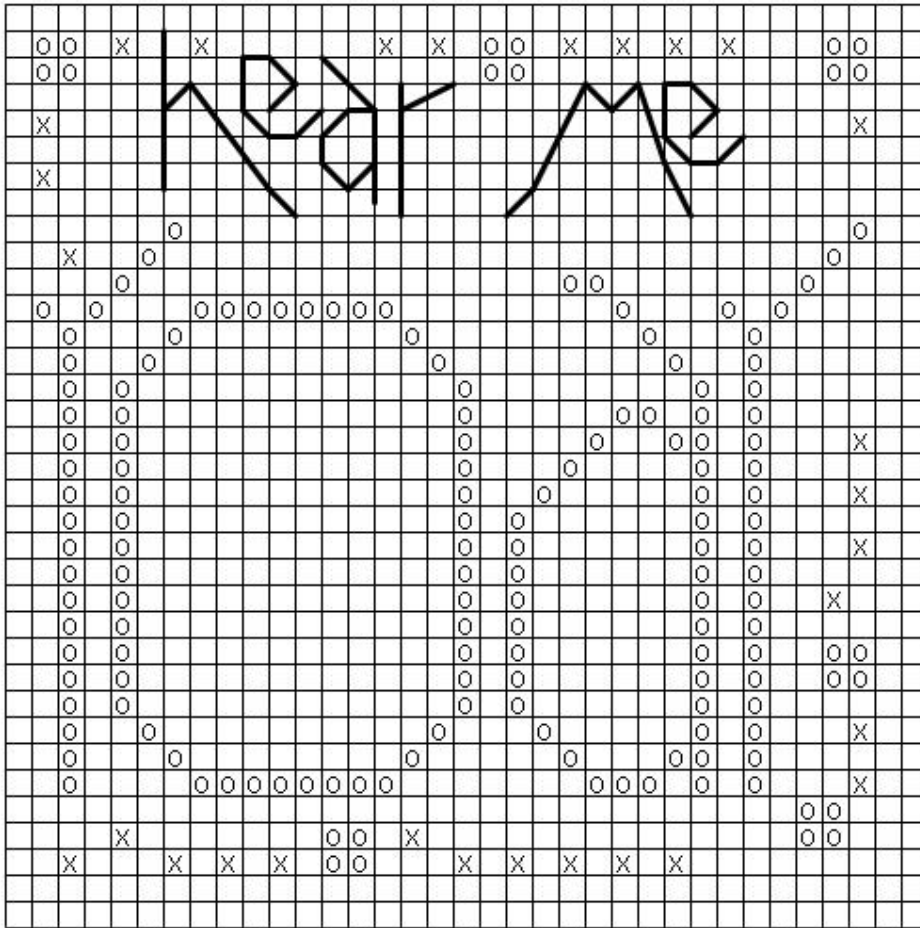

28 ct. Coffee Jobelan

Button: Wichelt #43118 Lion

Floss: DMC

Stitch Count 35 by 35

Cross stitch with 2 strands

O = 801 X = 434

Backstitch with 1 strand

Words in 310

Attach Lion button inside the letter O.

Supplies for Lion

2 7/8" Styrofoam block

Tan Felt

Tan Fur

4 - 3/4" Wood beads

Straight Pins and Sewing Needle

To Make your Lion:

Cut around finished design leaving 1 inch of excess fabric. Center the design on the cube and pin around edges. Cut a piece of felt 1 inch larger than cube and pin to back. For tail cut a felt strip 1 1/2 by 4 1/2 and roll, using matching thread tack to hold into a roll. Glue a small piece of fur to the end. Pin to the top backside. Cut a piece of felt that will completely cover cube on all sides, top and bottom. Pin on the underside where the felt will meet. Cut a piece of fur 1 inch wide and long enough to go around cube. Fold in half and pin to the front of your cube to create the mane. The pins will hide nicely in the fur. Glue a wood bead to the bottom of each corner for feet. We glued a small brown bow to the top of the tail.



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
